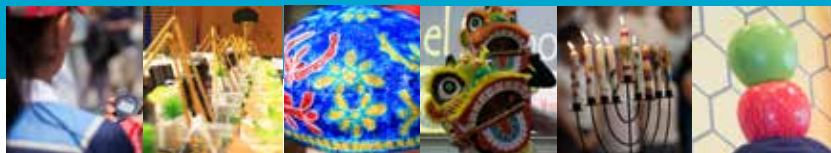

Message from Principal, Mrs. Rachel Friedmann

Dear Carmel School Parents and Student,

I am pleased to welcome back all Carmel families after what I hope has been an enjoyable summer break. A special welcome to new faculty and all new students.

I am delighted to congratulate our Graduating Class of 2018 on their excellent overall International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme (IB DP) scores. The International Baccalaureate is the most rigorous, globally recognised High School graduating programme: it is externally marked and moderated and all examinees across the world sit the exams on the same day. Over 160,000 candidates took the IB DP this year and an impressive average of 38 points (out of a possible 45) was achieved by Carmel's Elsa High School. It is important to remember that Carmel School is not selective; we are a comprehensive School with a comprehensive intake. Our 38 point average is significantly higher than the Hong Kong average of 35.96 and much higher than the IB DP global average of 29.78. University destinations for the 2018 graduates include Technion University, Bristol University, University St Andrews, UAL, Skidmore College and HKU. We are delighted for the graduates and proud of their personal achievements. I take this opportunity to thank the Carmel teachers and administration for their skill and dedication in supporting all students to achieve their very best.

All campuses have made an energetic and enthusiastic start today (Tzutzik and Ganeynu will start on Monday) and there is much excitement and focus on new initiatives and further development, of which we look forward to keeping you apprised.
