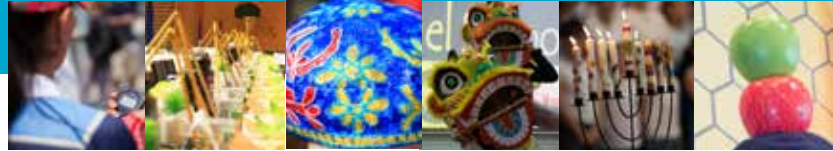

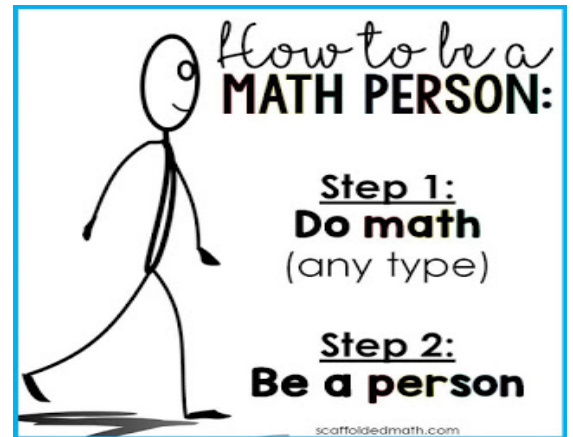

"Lashon Harah" - not for us! "לשון הרע לא מדבר אלי"

Today we introduced the important message of not speaking "lashon harah". We explained to the children that it is important to speak kindly to one another and to avoid 'gossip' or spreading rumors. This is especially relevant during the 10 days between Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur - '*aseret yemei teshuva*'.
