Grades 2 & 3 HK Heritage Museum Fieldtrip

Yesterday, Grade 2 and Grade 3 went on a field trip to the Hong Kong Heritage Museum. During the visit, the children were looking for examples of how Hong Kong expresses its culture.

The children were able to look at traditional Chinese porcelains, rare art, jewelry made of jade, and traditional costumes and clothing.

One of the highlights for the children was the Bruce Lee exhibition where the focus was on his contributions to the culture of Hong Kong as a result of his fame and Kung Fu skill. The impact that he had on modern culture is quite significant. It was a wonderful day out and children had a great time exploring some Hong Kong culture.
