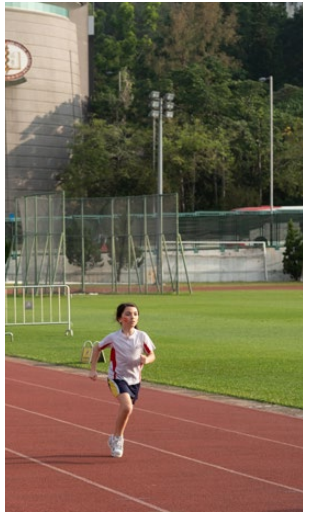
The children had a blast and we were very lucky to have sunny skies throughout Sports Day.

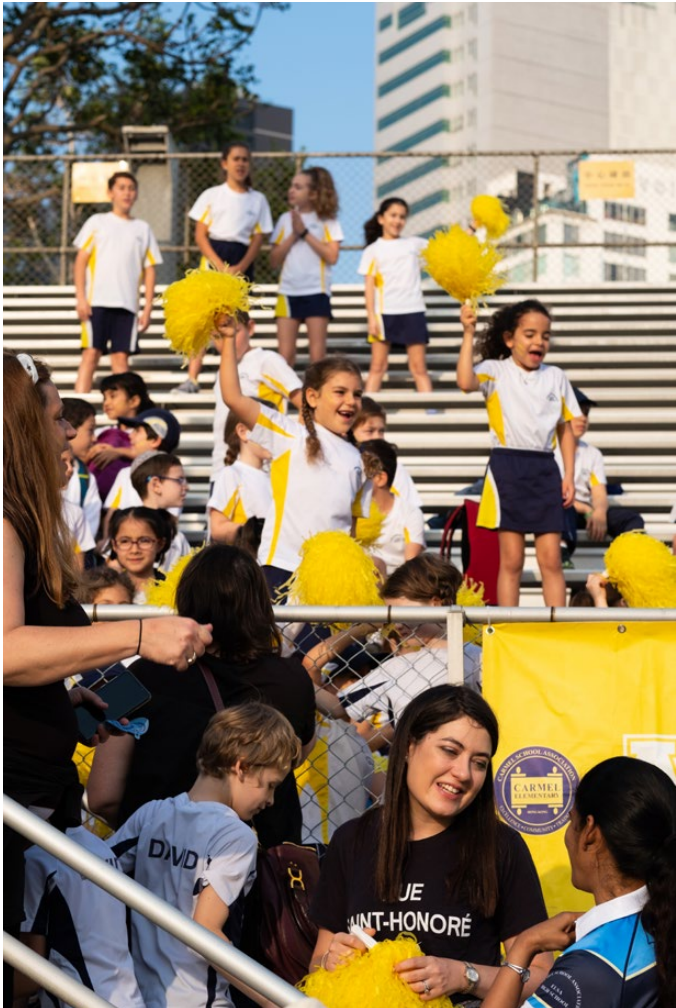
Congratulations to all the participants. The medals and ribbons will be presented next week. House winners will also be announced next week.

This Pesach, Carmel Elementary wants to hear your story.

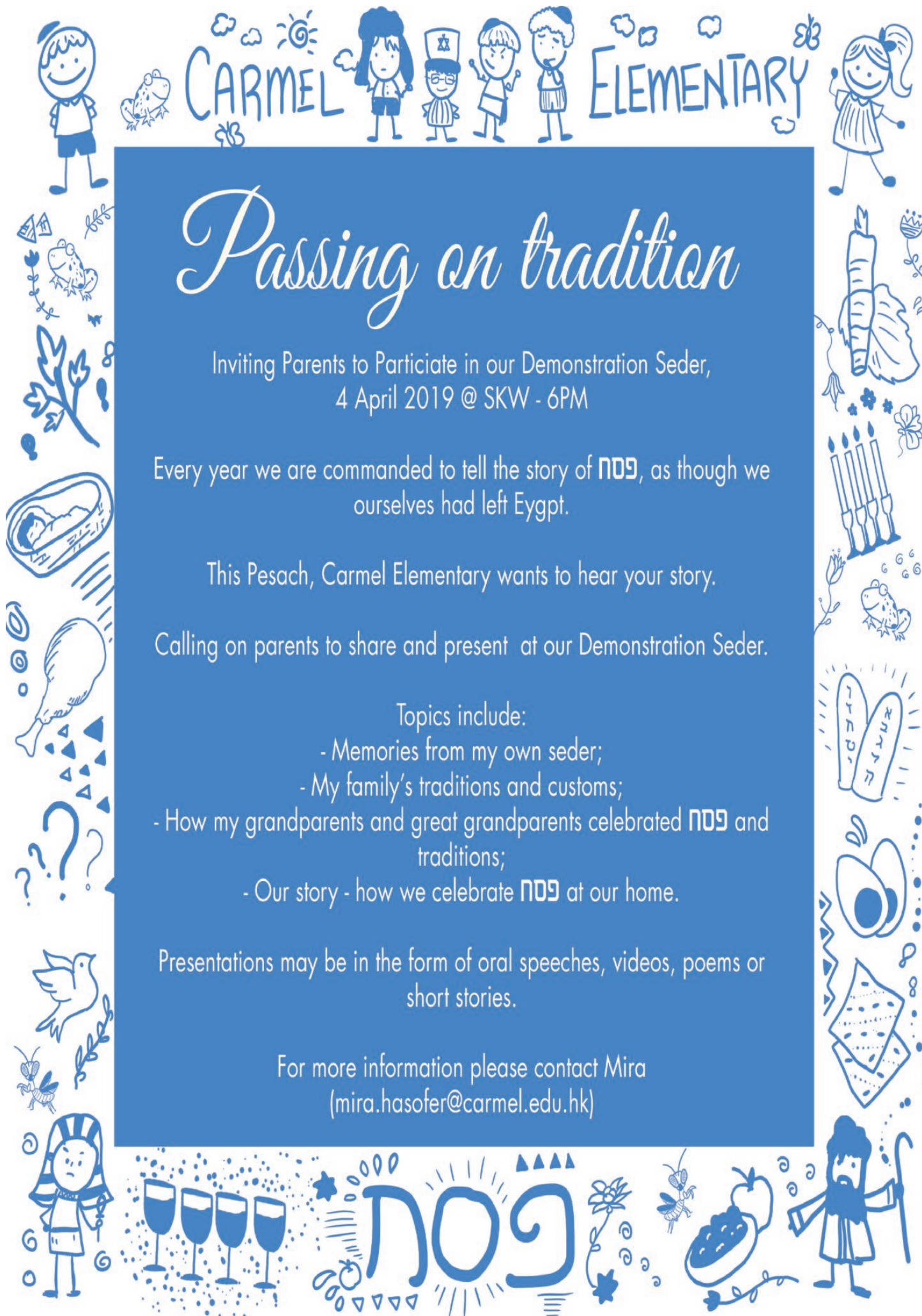
Calling on parents to share and present at our Demonstration Seder.


