Our K and G1 students have been busy exploring colour. Whilst most of us are familiar with primary and secondary colours, our K & G1 students are just learning how to mix and create new colours. Printing has been a great way to explore this concept, as the results are immediate. Gelli, mono and bubble printing techniques have all been investigated, and the artwork can be seen displayed around the school. G2 and 3 have also explored colour, but have used cacti as their inspiration for some observational drawings and collages. Our G4 & 5 transdiciplanry unit 'how we express ourself', has focused on street art. Students have been introduced to a variety of artists and have been exploring their techniques. The stencilling technique has been very popular. This work will also be displayed around the school when it is finished.

Students have already taken part in a street walk through SoHo, looking at messages conveyed through graffiti. Students also investigated modern and contemporary art and have also been learning about art history and artists, establishing a base of knowledge which allowed them to analyse and critique art.
