Dear Parents

The Pre School has had a few very busy weeks since the winter break. We have completed our second unit of inquiry and have found ways for the children to take ACTION and help save our oceans. We have completed a beach cleanup with some of the Elsa students and all participated in a sponsored walk, which helped us raise funds for Plastic Free Seas and Dolphin Conservation Society. We are also trying to reduce our plastic usage at the preschool and have begun a new initiative encouraging all the children to bring reusable Tupperware boxes for the Challah and cooking each week. We also had a wonderful Tu B'Shvat trip to Inspiration Lake.

To prevent the spread of flu in Kindergartens and childcare centres, The Education Bureau (EDB) announced on Friday that all Kindergartens and child care centres will have their Chinese New Year holiday advanced to start from Saturday 26 January 2019. We'd like to thank all of the parents and children for making such a great effort!
















Pre School Sponsored Walk

The Pre School children have begun learning all about taking ACTION. We have now completed our Sharing the Planet Unit of Inquiry and having learnt all about ways to protect and care for the ocean we decided to raise some funds for two amazing ocean related Hong Kong charities – Plastic Free Seas and Dolphin Conservation. On Thursday 24 January, all the Nursery and Pre-K children along with their parents/helpers participated in a sponsored walk at Happy Valley Racecourse.

The children all asked friends and family to sponsor them for one lap around the racetrack. Along the way the children were very excited to find pictures of different ocean animals and enjoyed sharing their knowledge about these animals and the ocean with their parents/helpers. We were honoured to have Dana Winograd from Plastic Free Seas join us for this event. Dana awarded each child with a metal straw at the end of the morning.

We would like to thank all the parents and helpers who joined us on our walk, and for making it a fun and memorable morning.



Plastic Free Seas

We were incredibly lucky to have Dana Winograd from 'Plastic Free Seas' come in and speak to us about the impact plastic has on our oceans. The children listened intently, shared their understanding and asked some great questions. We learned so much about how plastic is harming all of our animal friends and the small ways we can take action to reduce our plastic consumption- from using metal straws, to taking our own bags to the supermarket.

Following Dana's visit, we as a school have taken action ourselves, reducing plastic consumption. The children have noticed how much plastic we use each week for our Challah. This inspired the 'Challah Box Initiative'. We're encouraging the children to take action themselves, remembering to bring a box for their Challah and packing it away themselves. An excellent effort by all classes in the Pre-School!





Beach Cleanup

On Tuesday 15 January, Pre School students went on a trip to Stanley Beach to summarise their unit 'Sharing the Planet'. The children have been learning about rubbish in the ocean and the effects it has on the sea. We met with some Elsa High School science students there, who taught us a little about ocean pollution and what we can do to help. They showed us different bits of rubbish they had found whilst kayaking in Stanley Bay and discussed with us what we should do with our trash.

After the talk, students split into their classes and walked up and down the beach with their teachers showing rubbish for the teachers to collect. We sadly saw some ocean animals washed up on the shore, who had been affected by the pollution. We could see the similarities between plastic bags and jellyfish as we had seen them washed on the shore and discussed how easy it is for turtles and other animals to confuse the two.

To finish the day, we collected some beautiful shells and brought them back to school to clean; and we sorted the rubbish into the appropriate bins. Well done to Nursery and Pre-K for making a difference to your environment.








