On our return to school we then looked at all the different fruits and vegetables that had been bought and discussed if they were a fruit or a vegetable. We then read a book all about fruits and vegetables and found out that anything with 'seeds' is actually classified as a FRUIT! The children were fascinated by this fact!

we had everything we needed. Having paid each child placed an item into their (reusuable) shopping bag and we headed back to class. Of course we had to buy a treat for ourselves and the children enjoyed eating some cookies once back in the classroom. We are now super excited to start cooking and baking!




